### Five resolutions that will take care of your needs in 2012

So consider Smith's Treasure You Resolutions for the upcoming year:

#### 1. CELEBRATE BIRTHDAYS: YOURS AND YOUR FRIENDS', NOT JUST YOUR KID'S

"We should be able to celebrate another year of life," Smith said. "People are so humble about their birthdays. But you need to know that people care."

Smith said she and the members of her girlfriend's prayer group mark one another's birthdays throughout the year.

"It gives us a reason to get together and celebrate one another," she said.

#### 2. SCHEDULE DATE NIGHTS

"Set aside the time on your calendar for your relationship just like you would schedule your hair and nail appointments or other commitments," Smith said. "Follow through. You can't skip it. Don't let anyone interrupt you, even your kids — no matter how they try to make you feel."

She said she and Emmitt also agree not to talk about business while they're out together.

#### 3. SCHEDULE YOUR DOCTOR'S APPOINTMENTS

"At the beginning of the year, make all of your doctor's appointments for the entire year," she said. "We need to set our physician's appointments, mammogram appointments, dental appointments and female doctor appointments and stick to them."



Heart disease and cancer, the leading causes of death in women, can be prevented with proper screening, she said.

#### 4. SET A TREASURE YOU DATE

"If there's something that you've always wanted to do, set a date and do it," Smith said. "Write your goals down, hold yourself accountable. You'll feel a sense of obligation."

#### 5. SCHEDULE TREASURE YOU MOMENTS

"Take small moments whenever you can to focus on yourself," Smith said.

She offered these suggestions: read a book, take a nap, exercise, take a bubble bath, get a massage or travel somewhere you want to go.
